1 Day one - Arrival in Roma

Morning:

Fly into Roma and head straight to the Big Rig for an introduction to the early oil and gas industry and the stories that shaped the region.

Afternoon:

Visit Mount Abundance Homestead, one of the area's earliest pastoral properties. Students explore the homestead, gardens and outbuildings while learning about early settlement, land use and the development of agriculture in the Maranoa region.

Evening:

Attend the Big Rig Night Show, where the stories of Australia's early gas pioneers are brought to life through a mix of light, sound and multimedia.

2 Day two - Carnarvon Ranges

Full Day:

Spend the day exploring the Carnarvon Ranges with Boobook Explore. This guided experience showcases the region's towering sandstone cliffs, Indigenous rock art, unique flora and fauna, and the geological history that shaped the landscape. Students gain insight into landforms, biodiversity, cultural stories and conservation in a remote Outback environment.

3 Day three - Roma and Departure

Morning:

Visit the Roma Saleyards, the largest cattle-selling complex in the southern hemisphere. A guided tour explains livestock handling, marketing systems and the importance of the cattle industry to Queensland's economy.

Afternoon:

Transfer to Roma Airport and depart.
